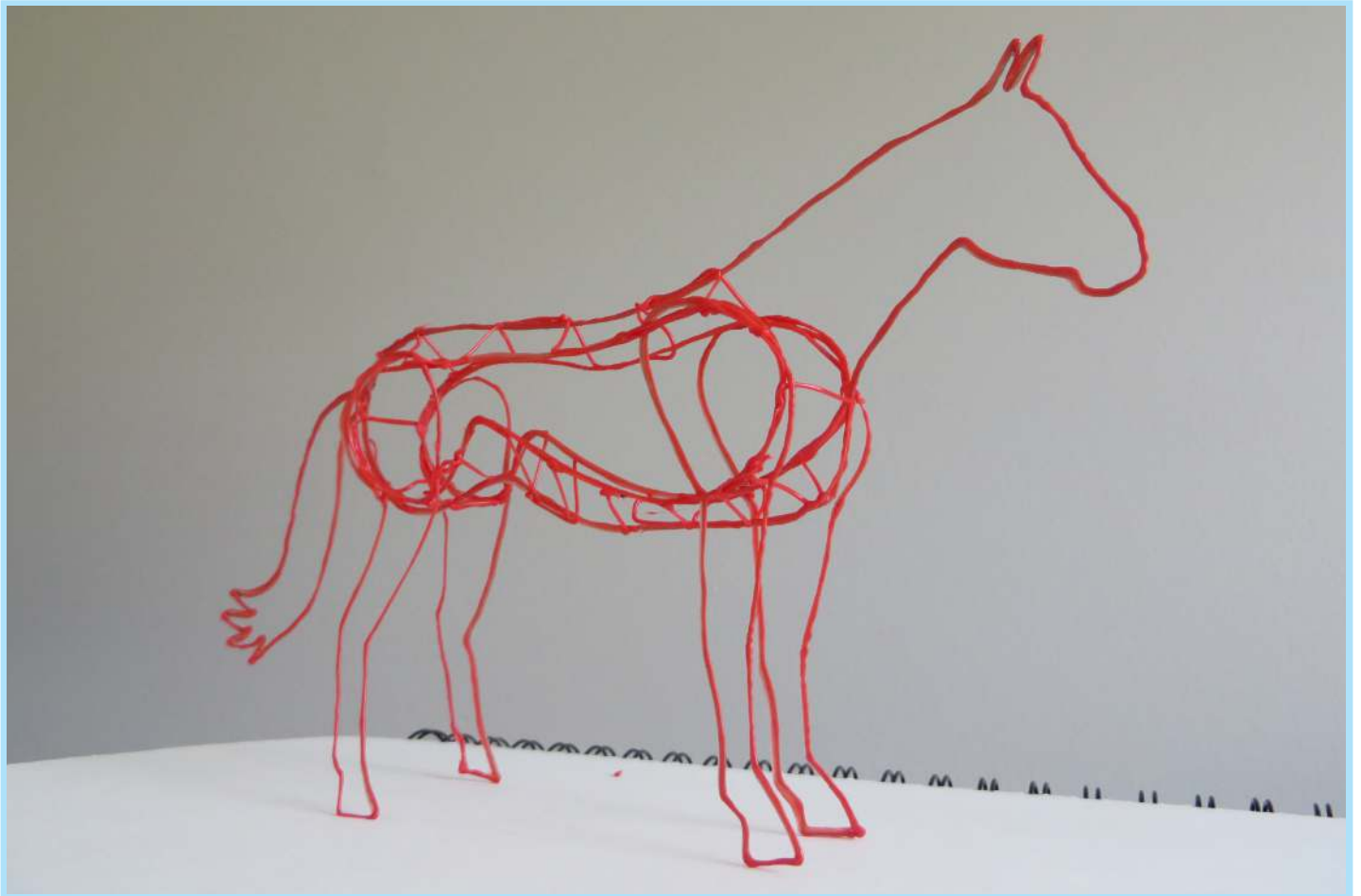

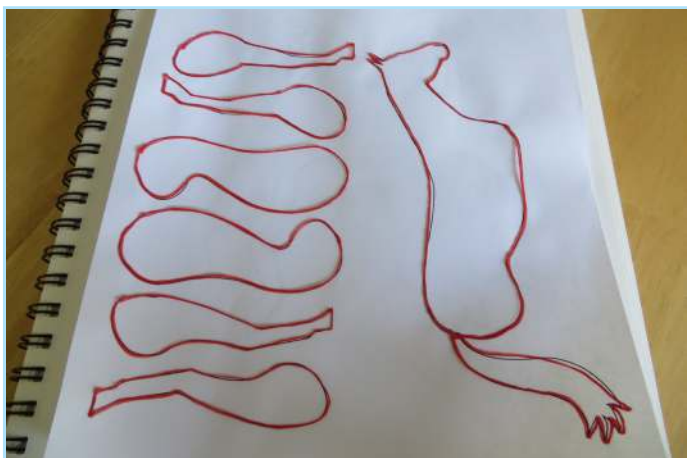
This tutorial will guide you through using a stencil to create a horse using thin lines to look like a 3D sketch. It will take one stick of filament to make the horse, and one more if you want to make the accessories on the second stencil.

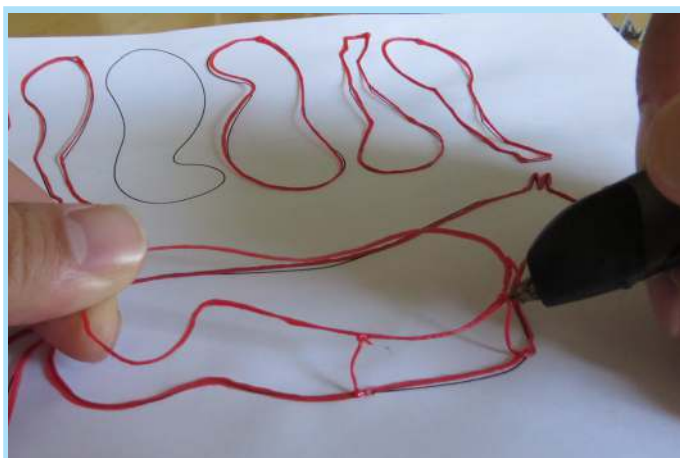


Step 1



Print out the stencil and trace the pieces. If the pieces are too flimsy go back over them.

Step 2



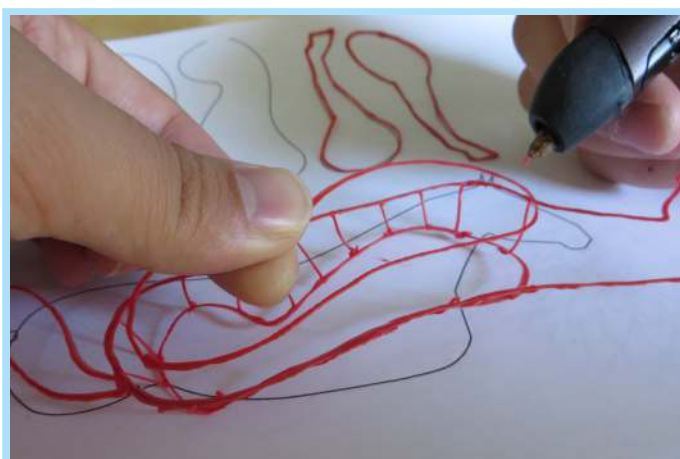
Lift up one of the smaller body pieces, hold it over the main body piece and connect them together like so.

Step 3



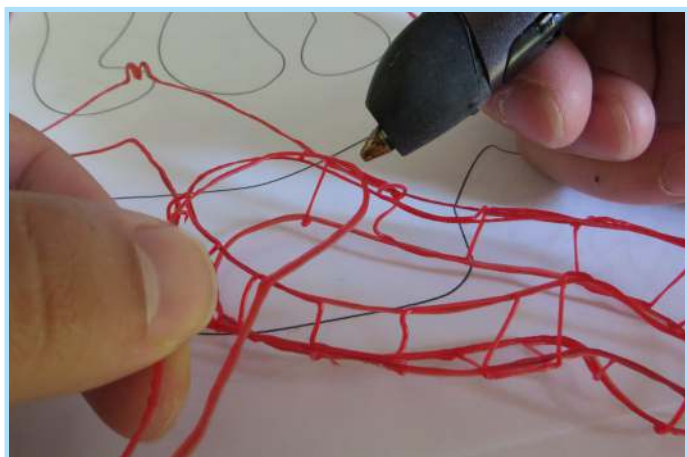
Work your way around the edges moving back and forth between the body shapes.

Step 4



Attach the other side of the body in the same way.

Step 5



Attach the legs to the outer body pieces.

Step 6



Make the sure the hooves are all even so the horse will stand.

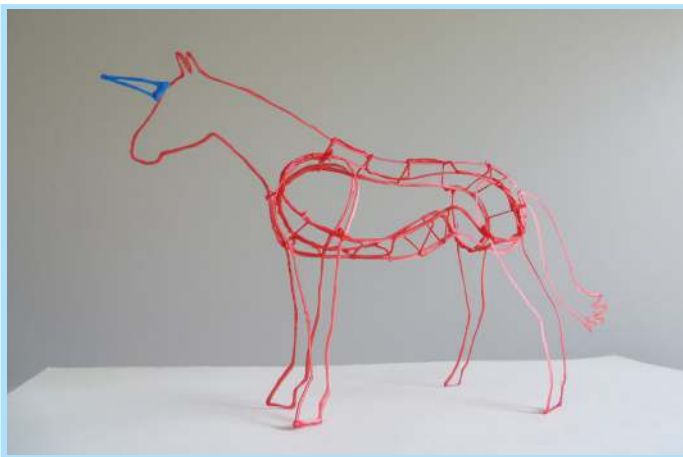


Step 7



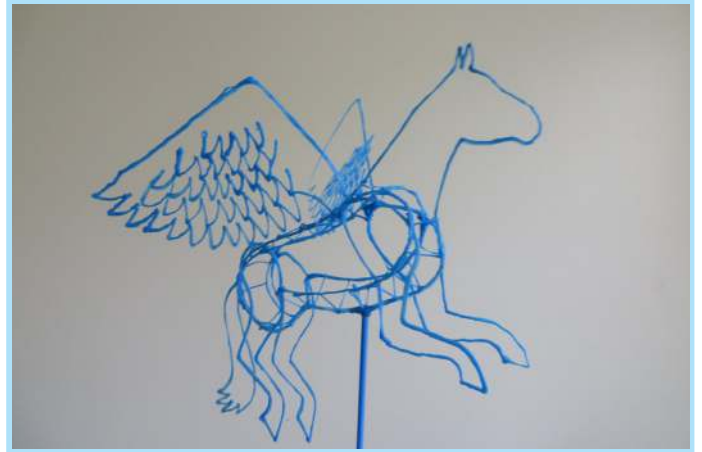
If you want, use the 2nd stencil to make a horn, wings, or alternate legs!

Step 9



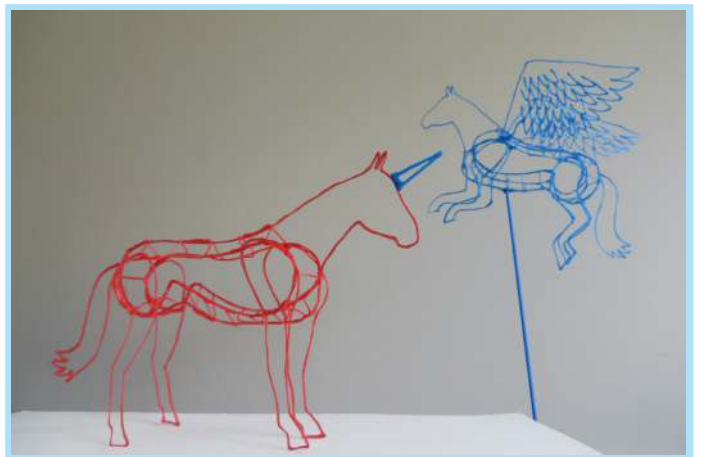
Add the horn to make a unicorn! Make your own pieces to personalize it! Does your horse have a wild mane? Maybe a saddle! Or battle armor!

Get mythical with a steed fit for a demigod!

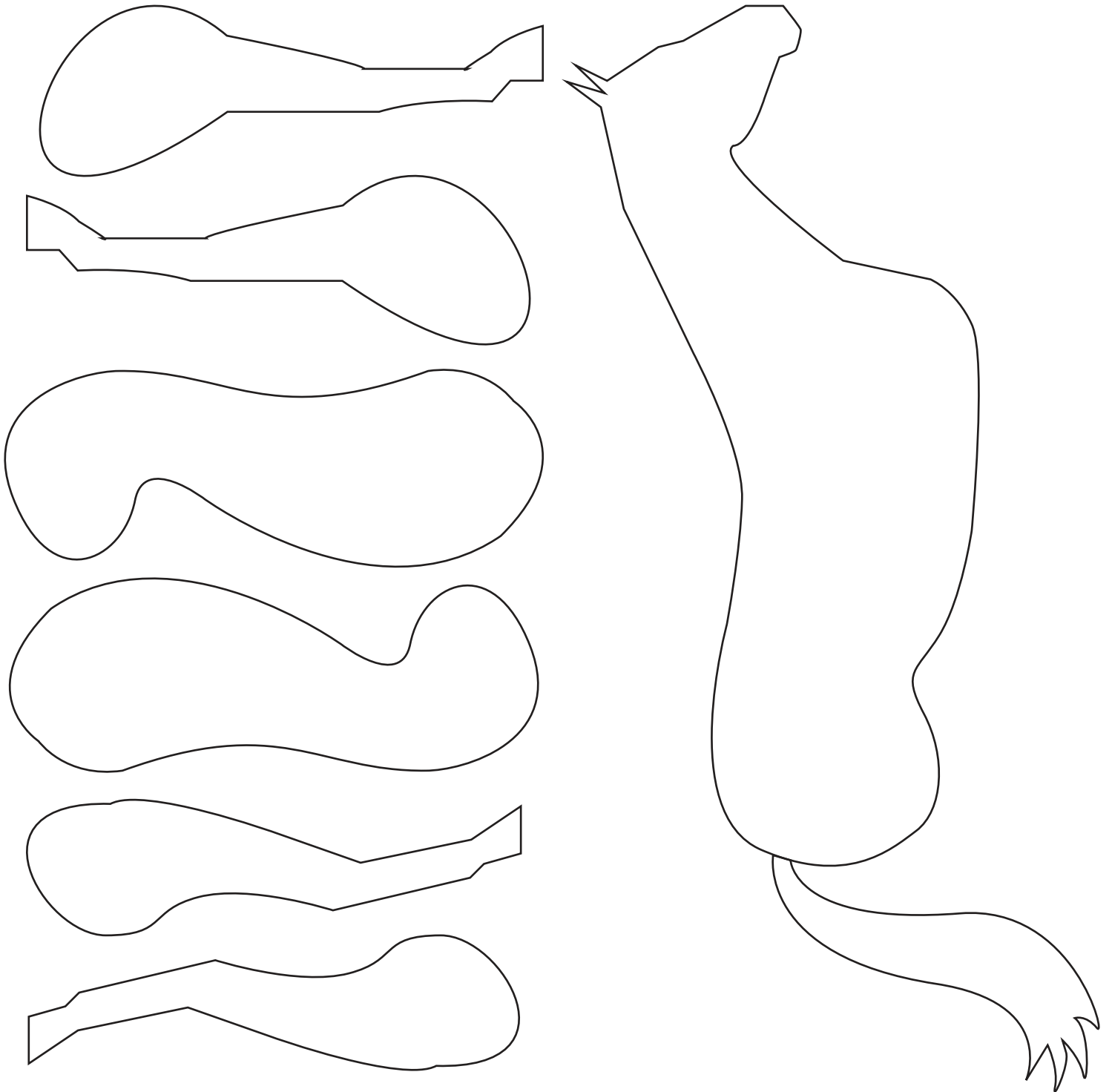
